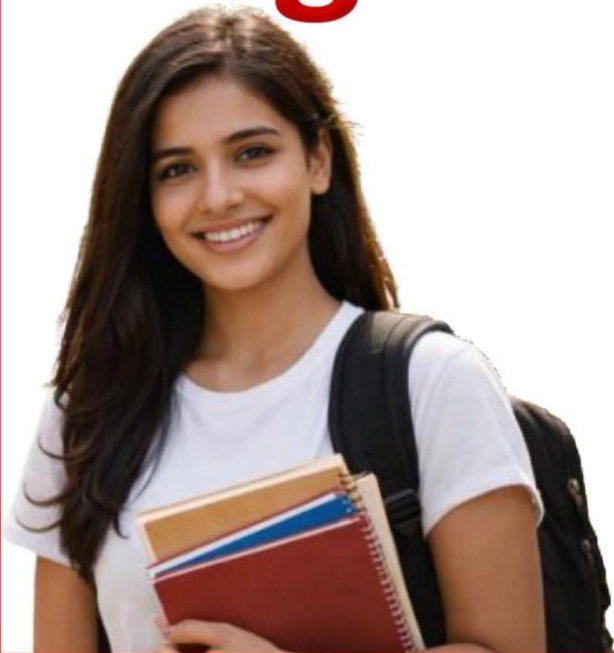
What is a dramatic monologue ?
